5 Days Of Prayer

As an ambassador for Summit, prayer is our top priority. Over the next five days, search your heart and surrender your plans to what the Lord wants to accomplish through you. The opportunity to share about Student Conferences is part of His work. Each summer, it is the Lord who brings the students and provides growth in their lives. As we serve together as ambassadors, we are not only preparing to share Summit's mission but also to shine the light of Truth in our communities.

Dedicate 10-15 minutes daily to praying, asking the Lord to go before you and prepare your heart. When speaking with parents and those working with Gen Z, remember that every family faces unique struggles and fears. Pray that God would give you a heart of encouragement and wisdom, offering the support parents need as they guide their teens in serving the Lord.

You have accepted a high calling. The rising generation is turning away from the Lord at an alarming rate, and we need the Holy Spirit's guidance every step of the way. We cannot do this on our own, but in our faithfulness, God will be glorified through each conversation.

The Summit team is cheering you on and is here to support you throughout this journey. We are praying with you as you commit to these next five days of prayer and preparation.

Day 1 - Wisdom

Strategies are important, but ultimately what we want to see in Gen Z, both in your community and beyond, is a movement toward God and a biblical worldview. No spiritual movement in history has ever begun without the foundation of prayer. As we seek to guide this generation, we must first commit to prayer, asking for God's wisdom and direction. Let us trust him to guide our efforts as we take the first steps toward impacting Gen Z with the truth of His Word.

Spend some time writing out your strategies and ask the Lord to give you more wisdom to develop the community engagement plan to recruit students he has for these next few months. Submit your plan in prayer to the Lord. Use the lines below to write out your plan and your own prayer of submission.

Verse

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." Proverbs 3:5-6

Prayer

Lord, you are the one who created each and every student in my city. You know what they are facing, and the hurts they are holding on to. Lord, reveal truth amidst the lies they are believing. Use me, Lord. Show me clearly the words to say and remind me that you are slow to speak. Guide my path and prepare my heart to see the work that you will do through me. I praise you, Lord, and trust your plan. Make my path straight as I think through strategies and make plans to engage my community about the important work you are doing at Summit Ministries. Open the gates, Lord!





Day 2 - Delight

What better way to spend our day than delighting in the Lord and the work He is doing. Even when the world tells us that Gen Z is walking away from the Lord, we know that our God is faithful to work in the lives of teens and young adults. As Summit Ambassadors, to “delight in the Lord” means finding joy in all the blessings that come from Him, not simply because they benefit us, but because they reflect His goodness. When we delight in the Lord, we value the Giver—God Himself—more than the gifts He provides. The Hebrew word for “delight” comes from a root meaning pleasure and enjoyment, reminding us to take true joy in who God is as we guide Gen Z toward seeking His truth and developing a relationship with Him.

Spend time today writing out what brings you delight as you prepare to serve families and the rising generation over the next few months. What excites you? Where does your hope lie? Why do you want to serve the Lord in this way?

Verse

Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart. Psalm 37:4

Prayer

Lord, I come before You with a heart that desires to delight in You above all else. Help me to find true joy in who You are, not just in the blessings You give. As I go out as an ambassador for Summit, guide me to lead Gen Z toward a deeper relationship with You. May they come to value You, the Giver, more than anything this world offers. Fill me with Your Spirit, so I can reflect Your love and truth to those I encounter. Give me wisdom and grace as I help them seek You, knowing that true fulfillment comes from delighting in You alone.





Day 3 - Surrender

As you start your day, search your heart and remember why you chose to be a Summit Ambassador. Ask the Lord to prepare your heart and mind to stay fixed on Him. Pray a prayer of anticipation and ask the Lord to use you as a vessel. Remember that the Lord is the one who will bring the increase in contacts, registered students, and deep conversations. Give your work and the plan you have to Him, and sit today in holy anticipation for what the Lord will do through you.

What are you excited to see the Lord do through your work as an ambassador? Use the lines below to outline your holy expectations for the next few months. examples: faith restored, authentic conversations, lives surrendered, students registered for a conference, etc.

Verse

"Even perfection has its limits, but your commands have no limit." - Psalm 119:96

Prayer

O God, everything around me, even that which looks so good, has a limit to its perfection, but not your word. Your word is limitless in its perfection. Your word is exceedingly good. I worship you, and I love your Word because it is perfect, infinitely perfect. Thank you that your limitless word breaks every limiting lie of the enemy over my life, in Jesus' name.





Day 4 - Consider

As you start your day, pray that the Lord will be a light to your path as you consider families, churches, and schools in your area to invite to a Student Conference this summer.

Make a list of 10-12 Families, their churches, and organizations that you would like the Lord to light your path to and go before you as you prepare to connect with them.

Verse

"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path." - Psalm 119:105

Prayer

O God, I praise you. I praise you for your leadership in my life today. Guide me, lead me, and direct me by your word in every way. I pray that in everything I do in my life, my family, my work, and in your church would have your supernatural leading from your Word. God, your word is the standard that supersedes my feelings, desires, and preferences. God, please cause your word to be a light to me in a dark world where and when I don't know what to do. May your word be my light today, in the mighty name of Jesus.





Day 5 - Sent

Just as Jesus called men and women into service, Summit Ambassadors help guide Gen Z toward His truth and participate in the redemption of His creation. Each of us has been uniquely equipped with gifts from God's Spirit. Our responsibility is to develop, refine, and use these gifts to lead this generation toward Him for the good of all. Together, we can point them to the truth found in Christ and help them build a firm foundation in God's Word.

What has the Lord shown you over the course of these 5 days? How has your strategy been strengthened as you have sat with the Lord this week? Use today to refine your plan and what you want to do over the next few months as a Summit Ambassador based on how God has been speaking to you.

Verse

"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here I am. Send me'". Isaiah 6:8

Prayer

Spirit of the living God, throughout every generation, You have raised up leaders to proclaim Your truth, justice, and love. As a Summit Ambassador, I am grateful for the calling You've given me to guide Gen Z toward You. I thank You for the presence of Your Holy Spirit, empowering me to share Your Word and lead this generation in seeking Your truth. I entrust this mission and all that I am to Your constant love and guidance. Fill me with grace, and grant me the strength and peace of Your Spirit as I help Gen Z discover a biblical worldview. Here I am, Lord, send me. Amen.





Next Steps:

If you haven't already, sign up for a group leader account in the registration system for Student Conferences. You will receive a group code to share with those you talk to. As a reminder, here are the discount tiers. You will decide how to distribute these credits to the students who pay their deposits and be able to apply the credits directly to student accounts through your group leader portal.

3-5 Students: \$100 credit per student

5-10 Students: \$250 credit per student

11+ Students: \$400 credit per student
